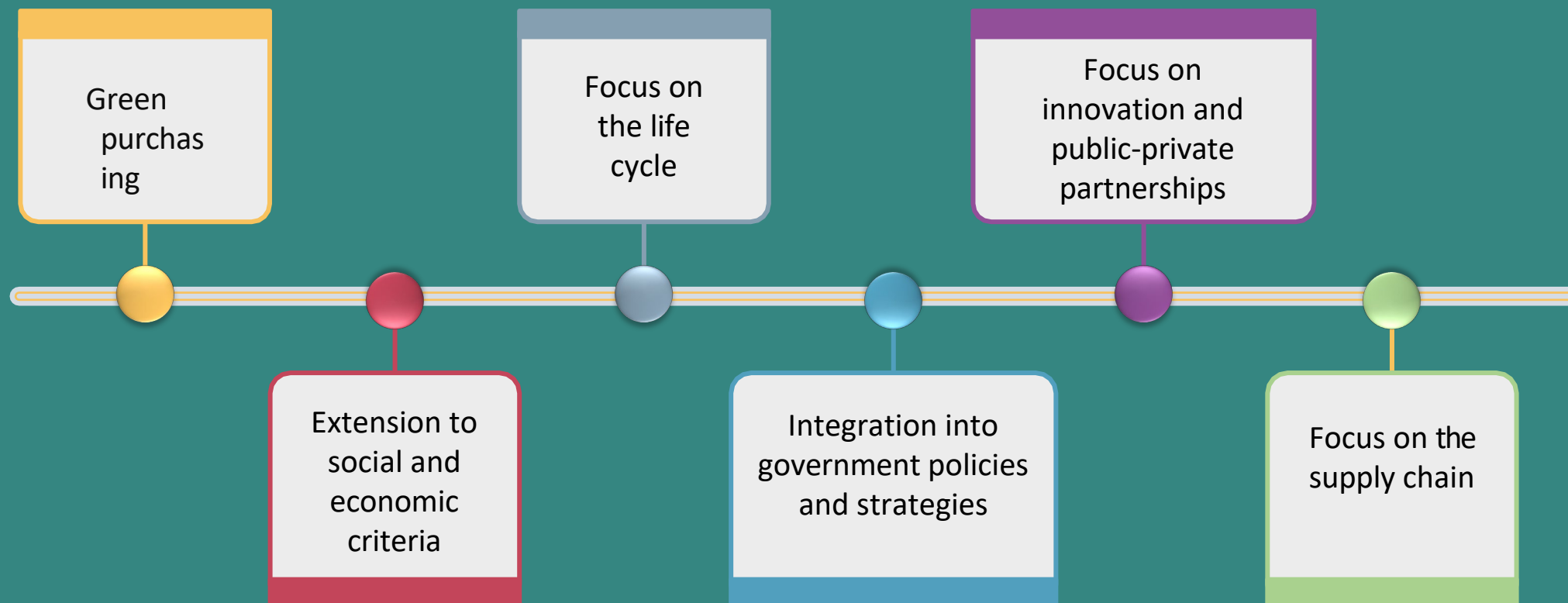

Virtual Store

Public procurement in Paraguay represents an average of 8% of the country's Gross Domestic Product (GDP), demonstrating its importance when designing and proposing policies for local development and economic reactivation.

In this regard, it is worth mentioning that the DNCP is firmly committed to the generation of mechanisms for development, such as the Virtual Store, a platform that enhances the implementation of Paraguay's Sustainable Public Procurement Policy.

MAKÁ PRODUCTS

Seeking to use the public procurement system as an engine for the economy of small communities, the DNCP activated in its Virtual Store indigenous products of Maká origin, to be purchased by State entities.

OBJECTIVE: Preserve, value, promote and disseminate the traditional craftsmanship of the Maká Indigenous Community, promoting its integration in the processes of socio-cultural and economic development of the country.



INTEGRATION IN THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT SYSTEM

Virtual Store of the DNCP:

- Indigenous products of Maká origin are now available.
- Fast and efficient purchasing, with response in less than 48 hours and purchase orders in less than 5 days.

Products available:

- Handmade bags and backpacks made with ancestral techniques.
- Use of cotton yarns of different colors.
